

## **CODING OLYMPIAD**

### **Conditions of Challenges Final Exam by Codementum**

1. **Exam Date:** 29 March 2026 - Sunday
2. **Exam Start Time:** 10:00 AM, morning (local time); not accessible for 24 hours.
3. **Exam Duration:** 90 minutes (Late arrivals will not receive additional time.)
4. **Exam End Time:** 11:30 AM, morning (local time); not accessible after this time.
5. **Exam Access:** Coding Olympiad Student Panel (not via Coding Olympiad)
6. **Exam Submission:**
  - Click END EXAM immediately after completing your exam to end it, as time taken is an important factor in the event of a tie.
  - If you do not click END EXAM button before the 90-minute period ends, the system will automatically save your progress and submit your answers when the time expires.
7. **Exam Structure:**
  - The challenges will cover all topics available in Codementum Studio.
  - You may freely switch between Block Mode and Code Mode (Python/JavaScript) during the exam.
  - The 30th challenge requires both coding and active on-screen interaction. After clicking the Run button, you must click on the obstacles using your mouse to assist the code in executing successfully.
8. **Evaluation and Scoring:**
  - Each challenge is automatically evaluated based on the accuracy and efficiency of your code.
  - The maximum number of stars you can earn for each challenge is three (3).
  - You may revisit any challenge with fewer than 3 stars and improve it within the 90-minute exam period.
  - Final Score Calculation: 30% of the Qualification Exam score + 70% of the Final Exam score
  - Students who did not take the Qualification Exam may still join; their results will be based only on the Final Exam (out of 70 points).
9. **Camera and Screen Monitoring:**
  - Enable your camera and share your entire screen before starting.
  - Keep your camera on and your face visible throughout the exam.
  - Students ranked in the top 10 who do not have camera recording and screen sharing enabled throughout the exam will be disqualified from the top 10.
10. **Independent Work:**
  - Use of external editors, AI tools, or help from others during the exam is strictly prohibited.
  - Violations will lead to score cancellation and disqualification.
11. **Technical Issues:**
  - If disconnected, re-enter your student panel and click START EXAM to resume from where you left off.
  - The countdown will continue, and your progress will be saved.
12. **Results:**
  - Results will be announced through the Coding Olympiad Student Panel within 14 days. You can download your report from your panel after that date.
